March 20 (E-60)	<b>Special Vote by Mail Ballot Requests</b> First day county elections official may process applications for 60-day travelers, military and overseas voters. EC 300(b), 3103
April 9 – April 28 (E-40 to E-21)	<b>State and Counties Mail Sample Ballots</b> Sample ballots shall be mailed to each voter registered by April 20. EC 9094(a), 13303
April 20 – May 12 (E-29 to E-7)	<b>Regular Vote by Mail Ballot Mailing</b> Vote by mail application requests will be processed during this period. EC 3001, 3205
May 4 (E-15)	<b>Last Day to Register</b> Last day to register for this election. Postmarks are acceptable. EC 2102, 2107
May 8 (E-11)	<b>Ballot Processing</b> Counties may begin processing vote by mail ballots. EC 15101(b)
No later than May 12 (E-7)	<b>Polls and Poll Worker Proclamations</b> Publish and Post Polling Places and Post Precinct Board Members in office and on website. The poll worker proclamation shall remain posted for 30 days after completion of the canvass. EC 12105
May 12 – May 19 (E-7 to E)	<b>Request for 7-Day Ballot</b> Voters unable to go to the polls or those voters who have misplaced or spoiled their ballot may come to the Election's Division and receive a ballot. EC 3021
May 19 (E)	<b>ELECTION DAY</b> Polls are open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. EC 14212
May 21 – June 16 (E+2 to E+28)	<b>Official Canvass of the Vote</b> The official canvass of precinct returns shall commence and be completed during this time. EC15301
