## Model 100 Precinct Ballot Tabulator / Scanner



Stanislaus County voters cast their ballots at the polls on the Model-100 precinct-based, voter- activated, paper ballot count tabulator.

Each poll has a Model-100. After marking the ballot, each voter personally and confidentially inserts their voted ballot into the Model-100, which sits directly over the ballot box. To promote ballot integrity and voter intent, the Model-100 alerts the voter to an over-voted race and an under-voted ballot before accepting the ballot. Then the Model-100 tabulates the voted ballot.

The Model-100 has been certified by the United States federal government, the State of California and is used in thousands of elections worldwide.
