Prior to a Candidate Soliciting or Accepting Contributions for Campaign Purposes	All candidates must file a Candidate Intention Statement (FPPC Form 501) with the county elections official before soliciting or accepting contributions to their campaign. Gov Code 85200
June 1	Stanislaus County Candidate Guide available. Copies of the guide will be available at 1021 "I" Street at the Registrar of Voters Office.
July 1 (E-125)	The final date the Notice To The County Clerk shall be delivered by the special district secretary to the county elections official stating offices to be filled, length of the term and who will pay for the statement of qualifications. Notices of boundaries and procedures to resolve a tie vote are also required by this date. EC 10509, 10522, 15651
July 3 (E-123)	Deadline for the County Superintendent of Schools to deliver to the county elections official the Specifications of the Election Order specifying the date of the election and the purpose of the election. Ed Code 5322
July 4 (E-122)	County Holiday – 4th of July
Jul 6 – Aug 5 (E-120 – E-90)	The Notice of Election shall be published between these dates containing the date of the general district election, name of the offices for which candidates may file, state the qualifications required for each office, location where declaration of candidacy forms will be available, where the forms are to be filed and the deadline for filing these forms. EC 12112
July 13 – August 7 5 p.m. (E-113 to E-88)	Candidate Nomination Period. First and last day for candidates to file for candidacy for this election. Statements of qualifications must also be filed during this period. Incumbents seeking election to their own office must file during this period. EC 10510
July 31 (E-95)	Semi-annual Campaign Committee Statement due for the period covering 1/1/09 – 6/30/09. Gov Code 84200
August 7 5 p.m. (E-88)	Close of Regular Candidate Nomination Period and the last day for governing bodies to Submit a Measure Resolution with the county elections official requesting consolidation with this election. Candidate nomination documents and candidate statements are due. Last day to withdraw declaration of candidacy papers except when there is an extension to that office. The Deadlines for Filing Measure Arguments will be determined by the election official when the resolution is submitted and filing deadlines will be published in a newspaper of general circulation. August 8 - August 12 5 p.m. (E-87 to E-83)	Extension of Candidate Nomination Period (for anyone other than the incumbent) if the incumbent did not file by August 7. EC 10407,10516,10604

August 13 11 a.m. (E-82)	Randomized alphabet drawing conducted by the Secretary of State to determine candidate name order as it will appear on the ballot. EC 13111(i), 13112
September 4 (E-60)	First day county election official may process applications for Special Vote by Mail Ballot Requests (Military, Overseas and 60 Day Voters). EC 300(b), 3103
September 7 (E – 57)	County Holiday – Labor Day
September 24 – October 13 (E-40 to E-21)	Between these dates the county shall mail the Sample Ballot Pamphlets to each voter who registered by E 29. EC 13303
September 24 (E-40)	1st FPPC Pre-election campaign statement due for the period covering 7/1/09 – 9/19/09. Gov Code 84200.7(b)(1)
October 5 – October 27 (E-29 to E-7)	Regular Vote by Mail Ballot mailing and processing period. Ballots will be available at the county elections office. EC 3001
October 18 – November 2 (E-16 to E-1)	Late Contributions and Independent Expenditures of \$1000 or more must be filed within 24 hours with the county election official during this period. Gov Code 84200.7(b)(1)
October 19 (E-15)	Last Day to Register for this election. Postmarks are acceptable. EC 2107
October 22 (E-12)	2nd FPPC Pre-election campaign statement due for the period covering 9/20/09 – 10/17/09. Gov Code 84200.7(b)(2)
October 27 (E – 7)	Publish Polling Places and Post Precinct Board Members EC 12105, 12105.5
October 28 – November 3 (E-6 to E)	Special 7- day vote by mail ballots are available at the county election official's office for those voters unable to vote at the polls on election day. EC 3021
November 3 (E)	ELECTION DAY Polls are open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. EC 1000, 14212
November 5 –November 23 (E+2 to E+20)	The Official Canvass of precinct returns shall commence and be completed during this time. The county election official prepares a certified statement of results and submits it to the governing bodies involved with this election. EC 15301, 15372
December 4 (E+31)	Elected and Appointed District Officials will take office on the first Friday in December following this election. EC 10554
Feb 1, 2010*	Semi-annual campaign finance statement due for the period covering 10/18/09 – 12/31/09. Gov Code 84200

* Falls on a holiday or weekend...moved to next business day.
