<b>See Attached Measure Consolidation Calendar</b>	<p><b>Governing Bodies Requesting Measure Consolidation</b> Pursuant to EC 10403, Measure Resolutions are to be submitted to the Board of Supervisors requesting consolidation with this election by E-88; however the ROV has <u>administrative deadlines</u> necessary to meet vendor and print deadlines. See attached <i>Measure Consolidation Calendar</i> for ROV administrative deadlines.</p>
<b>July 14 (E-114)</b>	<p><b>Municipal Calling of Special Election to Fill Vacancy</b> Last date for a city council to call a special election to fill a vacancy on the next regularly established election date, to be held not less than 114 days from the call of the election. If the election is not called by this date, the vacancy cannot go to election on this established election date. <span style="float: right;"><i>GC 36512 (b)</i></span></p>
<b>July 1 – July 15 (E-127 to E-113)</b>	<p><b>Municipal Notice of Election</b> For cities consolidating with this election, the city clerk shall publish the Notice of Election between these dates. This notice shall contain the date of the election, polling hours, any offices to be filled and or/measures to be voted on, the qualifications required for each office, location where declaration of candidacy forms will be available, where the forms are to be filed and the deadline for filing these forms. <span style="float: right;"><i>EC 12101, 12111</i></span></p>
<b>July 4</b>	<p><b>Holiday – County Elections Office Closure</b></p>
<b>July 5 (E-123)</b>	<p><b>Specifications of the Election Order</b> School boards shall deliver this document to the County Superintendent of Schools and the county election official. <span style="float: right;"><i>ED Code 5322</i></span></p>
<b>July 8 – August 7 (E-120 to E-90)</b>	<p><b>Notice of Election</b> This notice shall be published between these dates and shall contain the date of the general district election, name of the offices for which candidates may file, state the qualifications required for each office, location where declaration of candidacy forms will be available, where the forms are to be filed and the deadline for filing these forms. <span style="float: right;"><i>EC 12112</i></span></p>
<b>July 15 – August 9 5:00 p.m. (E-113 to E-88)</b>	<p><b>Candidate Nomination Period</b> Candidates (including incumbents seeking re-election to the same office) must file nomination documents with the county election official during this period. Candidate Statements of Qualifications are due during this period. <span style="float: right;"><i>EC 10220, 10510, 13307</i></span></p>
<b>July 31</b>	<p><b>FPPC Semi-annual Campaign Statement Due</b> For period covering 1/1/13 – 6/30/13. <span style="float: right;"><i>GC 84200, 84218</i></span></p>
<b>August 7 – November 4 (E-90 to E-1)</b>	<p><b>Late Contributions and Independent Expenditures of \$1000 or More</b> Within 24 hours of the transaction, FPPC Form 462 <u>and</u> Form 496 or Form 497 must be filed with the appropriate filing officer <span style="float: right;"><i>GC 82036, 82036.5, 84200.6</i></span></p>
<b>August 9 5:00 p.m. (E-88)</b>	<p><b>Close of Regular Candidate Nomination Period</b> Candidate nomination documents are due. Incumbents who wish to file as a candidate for their own office must file by this date. Last day to withdraw declaration of candidacy papers except when there is an extension to that office. Statements of Economic Interest Form 700 are due. <span style="float: right;"><i>EC 8020, 10407; GC 87201</i></span></p>

<b>August 10 - August 14</b> 5:00 p.m. (E-87 to E-83)	<b>Extension of Candidate Nomination Period</b> Extension period for candidates other than the incumbent <u>if</u> the incumbent did not file by E-88. This provision does not apply if there is no incumbent to be re-elected. <i>EC 10225, 10407, 10516, 10604</i>
<b>August 15</b> 11:00 a.m. (E-82)	<b>Randomized Alphabet Drawing</b> Conducted by the Secretary of State to determine candidate name order as it will appear on the ballot. <i>EC 13112</i>
<b>August 15 – August 25</b> (E-82 to E-72)	<b>10-day Public Examination Period For Statement of Qualifications</b> During this period any voter of the jurisdiction, or the county elections official may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction must be filed no later than the end of this period. <i>EC 13313</i>
<b>September 2</b>	<b>Holiday – County Elections Office Closure</b>
<b>September 6</b> (E-60)	<b>Special Vote By Mail Ballot Requests</b> First day the county elections official may process applications for special vote by mail ballot requests (Military, Overseas and 60-day voters). <i>EC 300, 3103</i>
<b>September 26 – October 15</b> (E-40 to E-21)	<b>Sample Ballot Pamphlets</b> Pamphlets are mailed to each registered voter during this time. <i>EC 13303</i>
<b>September 26</b> (E-40)	<b>1<sup>st</sup> FPPC Pre-election Campaign Statement Due</b> For the period covering 7/1/13 – 9/21/13. <i>GC 84200.7(b)(1)</i>
<b>October 7 – October 29</b> (E-29 to E-7)	<b>Regular Vote by Mail Ballot</b> Mailing and processing period for Vote by Mail ballots. Ballots will be available at the county elections office. <i>EC 15101</i>
<b>October 21</b> (E-15)	<b>15-Day Close</b> Last day to register for this election. Postmarks, DMV and personal delivery to the election office are acceptable. <i>EC 2107</i>
<b>October 24</b> (E-12)	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> FPPC Pre-election Campaign Statement Due</b> For the period covering 9/22/13 – 10/19/13. <i>GC 84200.7(b)(2)</i>
<b>October 30 – November 5</b> (E-6 to E)	<b>Special 7- day Ballots Available</b> Available at the county election official's office for those voters unable to vote at the polls on Election Day. <i>EC 3021</i>
<b>November 5</b> (E)	<b>ELECTION DAY</b> Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. <i>EC 1000, 14212</i>
<b>November 7 –November 25</b> (E+2 to E+20)	<b>Canvass of the Vote</b> Official canvass of precinct returns shall commence and be completed during this period. The ROV shall prepare a certified statement of the results and submit it to the governing bodies involved with this election. <i>EC 15301, 15372</i>
<b>December 6</b> (E+31)	<b>Elected and Appointed District Officials Will Take Office</b> At noon on the first Friday in December following this election. <i>EC 10554</i>
<b>January 31, 2014</b>	<b>FPPC Semi-annual Campaign Statement Due</b> For period covering 7/1/13 – 12/31/13. <i>GC 84200, 84218</i>

<p><b>Measure Consolidation</b></p>	<p><b>Governing Bodies Requesting Measure Consolidation</b> Pursuant to EC 10403, Measure Resolutions are to be submitted to the Board of Supervisors requesting consolidation with this election by E-88; however the ROV has <u>administrative deadlines</u> necessary to meet vendor and print deadlines.</p>
<p><b>June 21, 2013 (E-137)</b></p>	<p><b>Consolidation of a Measure with the General District Election (UDEL)</b> Last day to submit Resolution requesting consolidation to Board of Supervisors to be calendared for the July 2, 2013 meeting. Resolution to include: request for ROV to provide services, ballot question (75 word limit), passage requirements, full text (including Tax Rate Statement and Fiscal Impact Report, if applicable), and Impartial Analysis. Such request shall be made to the Board of Supervisors and a copy of the request to the ROV. <i>EC 9140, 9160, 9222, 9280, 9313, 10002, 10403</i></p>
<p><b>July 2, 2013</b></p>	<p><b>Board of Supervisors Meeting</b> Calendar date for BOS to approve consolidation.</p>
<p><b>July 8, 2013 (E-120)</b></p>	<p><b>Publication</b> For <b>Special District Measures</b>, the County Election Official shall publish a public notice including the election date, election location, ballot question, passage requirement and argument and rebuttal deadlines. <i>EC 9163</i>  For <b>Municipal Measures</b>, the City Clerk shall publish a public notice including the election date, election location, ballot question, passage requirement and argument and rebuttal deadlines. <i>EC 9205</i></p>
<p><b>July 18, 2013 (E-110)</b></p>	<p><b>Deadline: Arguments For and Against</b> <i>GC 57146; EC 9162, 9282, 9315</i></p>
<p><b>July 30, 2013 (E-98)</b></p>	<p><b>Deadline: Rebuttals to Arguments For and Against</b> <i>EC 9167, 9285, 9286, 9317</i></p>
<p><b>August 9, 2013 (E-98 to E-88)</b></p>	<p><b>10-Day Public Examination Period</b> <i>EC 9190, 9380, 9286, 9295</i></p>
<p><b>November 5, 2013</b></p>	<p><b>Election Day</b> <i>EC 1000</i></p>
