Measure Consolidation	<p>Governing Bodies Requesting Measure Consolidation Pursuant to EC 10403, Measure Resolutions are to be submitted to the Board of Supervisors (BOS) requesting consolidation with this election by E-88; however the ROV has <u>administrative deadlines</u> necessary to meet vendor and print deadlines.</p>
	<p>Local Special Election The governing body of the local agency shall issue a proclamation or a resolution calling the election. <i>EC 12001</i></p>
	<p>10-Day Public Examination Period Copies of the measure, analysis, full text and arguments are made available to the public for inspection. Any voter of the jurisdiction may seek a writ of mandate or injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. <i>EC 9190, 9380, 9286, 9295</i></p>
	<p>Resolution Requesting Election Services Resolution requesting approval from the Board of Supervisors (BOS) for ROV to provide election services must be filed with BOS and ROV. Resolution to include: request for ROV to provide specific services, date of election, ballot question (75 word limit), passage requirements, <i>Full Text</i> of measure, Tax Rate Statement, if applicable, and Fiscal Impact Report, if applicable. <i>EC 9140, 9160-9168, 9313, 10002</i></p>
March 31, 2020	<p>Board of Supervisors Meeting Calendar date for BOS to approve ROV services.</p>
	<p>The city clerk shall provide all required notices and publications for this election.</p>
May 8, 2020 (E-109)	<p>Publications - Municipal Notice of Election The city clerk shall publish a Notice of Election that includes the election date, ballot question, passage requirement, argument and rebuttal argument filing deadlines, location to file arguments and the central count location (county elections office) in a newspaper of general circulation. <i>EC 9205, 12109</i></p> <p>Municipal Measures, the city clerk shall publish a synopsis of the measure at least one time not later than one week before the election in a newspaper of general circulation in the city. <i>EC 12111</i></p>
May 18, 2020 (E-99)	<p>Deadline: Arguments For and Arguments Against - File with city clerk 300 word limit for arguments. <i>GC 57146; EC 9162, 9282, 9315</i> 10-Day Public Examination Period: May 19 – May 28</p>
May 28, 2020 (E-89)	<p>Deadline: Rebuttal to Argument For and Rebuttal to Argument Against – File with city clerk 250 word limit for rebuttal arguments. <i>EC 9167, 9317</i> 10-Day Public Examination Period: May 29 – June 7</p>
May 28, 2020 (E-89)	<p>Deadline: Impartial Analysis - File with city clerk 500 word limit impartial analysis must be submitted by this date. <i>EC 9313</i> 10-Day Public Examination Period: May 29 – June 7</p>

<p>June 26 to July 11 (E-60 to E-45)</p>	<p>Military / Overseas Voter Mail Ballots Mailing and processing period for military and overseas voters. <i>EC 300, 3103</i></p>
<p>July 27 to August 15 (E-29 to E-10)</p>	<p>Mail Ballot Election The county elections official shall commence mailing the voter information guide and official ballots on the 29th day before the election and shall complete the mailing by the 10th day before the election. <i>EC 4101</i></p>
<p>August 10 (E-15)</p>	<p>15 Day Close Last day to register for this election. <i>EC 2107</i></p>
<p>August 11 to August 25 (E-14 to E)</p>	<p>Conditional Voter Registration Period Eligible persons who missed the 15 day close of registration may appear <u>in person</u> at the county elections official's office and register to vote provisionally for this election. <i>EC 2170</i></p>
<p>August 25 (E-0)</p>	<p>Election Day Mailed ballots must be post-marked by August 25 and received by the county elections official by August 28. Ballots delivered in person must be received no later than 8:00 p.m. at the county elections official's office located at 1021 "I" Street, Modesto, CA. <i>EC 3020</i></p>
<p>August 27 to September 24 (E+2 to E+30)</p>	<p>Canvass of the Vote Canvass of the vote shall commence and be continued daily, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excepted, for not less than six hours each day until completed. The ROV shall prepare a certified statement of the results and submit it to the governing body. <i>EC 15301, 15372</i></p>

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, whenever a date prescribed by law falls on a weekend or holiday, such act may be performed on the next business day. *EC 15; GC 6700, 6701*
