January 4, 2016 – January 23, 2016 (E-29 to E-10)	Mail Ballot Election Mailing and processing period for ballots. Ballots will be available at the county elections office. EC 4101
January 18, 2016 (E-15)	15-Day Close Last day to register for this election. Postmarks, DMV and personal delivery to the elections office are acceptable. EC 2107
January 19, 2016 (E-14)	Publish Drop Off Sites / Central Count Location The county elections official will publish the drop off site location(s) and central count location in a newspaper of general circulation. EC 12109
February 2, 2016 (E)	ELECTION DAY Ballots must be received at the designated drop off sites by 8:00 pm or post-marked by February 2 nd and received by the county elections officials within three days. EC 3020
February 4, 2016 – March 3, 2016 (E+2 to E+30)	Canvass of the Vote Canvass of the vote shall commence and be continued daily, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excepted, for not less than six hours each day until completed. The county elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results and submit it to the City of Modesto. EC 15301, 15372
