POSITIONS AVAILABLE & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Inspector:

- Pick up and maintain election supplies on Election Day
Arrange for access and keys to polling place
Return ballots and supplies at close of polls
Assist voters on Election Day
Attend a training class prior to Election Day
Receive \$130 stipend

Judge:

- Assist Inspector with Election Day duties
Assist voters on Election Day
Attend a training class prior to Election Day
Receive \$95 stipend

Qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older
U.S. citizen & registered California voter OR
legal permanent resident of the U.S.
Able to serve the entire Election Day

Volunteer Hours:

- Arrive at 6 a.m.
Polls open at 7 a.m.
Polls close at 8 p.m.
Leave at approximately 10 p.m.
(or until duties are complete)
