## Voting Accessibility Advisory Committee (VAAC) Wednesday, July 23, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. Meeting Minutes

The group explored various service delivery methods including in person interpreters, VRI, and pre-recorded videos, while considering budget constraints and local interpreter availability. They discussed outreach opportunities and voter education strategies, including participation in community events and sharing best practices from other counties.

Jennie to look into Multilingual Virtual Poll Worker System offered by Inclusion Solutions which was brought up by Karie Lew.

ROV asked for ideas for outreach opportunities to recruit deaf and hard of hearing poll workers and volunteers that can assist during an election. Jessica will be sending information on ROV having a

booth at Family Day in Stockton on 9/13/25. ROV considering offering to partner with San Joaquin ROV at a booth for event.

Karie shared videos from Washington State and South Carolina that include ASL interpretation and captions, suggesting these could serve as models for California.
